

Study in Lithuania - Information

Students in Lithuania have the opportunity to choose from a wide range of courses and programs, each designed to cultivate the knowledge and skills you need to pursue a lucrative career or further academic study. Lithuania is one of the top destinations for medicine and technology studies. Most of the country's universities and colleges are state-run but there are also private ones you can choose from.

The choice is mainly based on the score of the high school diploma or vocational school. Undergraduate studies last 3 to 4 years, postgraduate studies 1-2 years and doctoral studies depend on each program.

For admission to Lithuanian universities, you need a high school diploma however criteria vary from university to university and for some faculties you may need to take a multiple-choice examination defined by each university.

The examinations are done in our offices of the University Studies Counselors of Lithuania in Cyprus by professors who come to Cyprus for this purpose.

Applications for the University start in January of each year. In order for a student to attend the entrance exams, they must first apply by filling out the special form application and provide the following documents.

- Family doctor certificate (stating that the candidate is healthy).
- High school diploma officially translated into English. (The 'official' translation is done at the Press and Information Office).
- Certificates of the Baccalaureate from the Competent Ministries of Education and Justice, (APOSTILLE).
- 2 passport photos.
- Copy of Passport.
- Copy of Political Identity.
- Certificate proving English language proficiency (eg GCE, IELTS etc).
- Curriculum vitae.
- Report from the student explaining why he chose the science he wants to study.
- Family doctor certificate (stating that the candidate is healthy).

Tuition costs vary from university to university and range from 4,000 up to 12,500 depending on the field of study, the city and the universities

The duration of studies is from 4 to 6 years depending on the study and each academic year is divided into 2 semesters from September to January and from February to June.

Lithuania is one of the cheapest countries in the European Union.

Students can choose to stay in dormitories or apartments where the cost of living for students in dormitories does not exceed € 500 per month (including rent and general expenses). Lithuania is a Baltic country in northwestern Europe, west of Germany bordering Poland, Latvia and Belarus. It is a member state of the European Union (with the euro as its currency), a very hospitable country with peaceful citizens. It has a great and ancient civilization, as in the Middle Ages it was an empire.
